## **Investing in your Home**



## What's your Style?

When planning a Kitchen Renovation, one term you will regularly hear is "The Work Triangle". This is the area in the Kitchen where you will be spending most of your time. The three points of the triangle are generally represented by your sink, stove/range, and refrigerator. The triangle is not a hard and fast rule, but it is something to keep in mind to help minimize footsteps and make the overall flow work better. A common designer rule of thumb is that the sum of the triangle should not exceed 26 feet.

## **Measuring your Kitchen**


Please provide the dimensions of your space. When you choose KENT to install your kitchen, we will send one of our Installation Specialists to verify all measurements before the cabinets are ordered.



#### What to Measure:

#### RECORD ALL MEASUREMENTS IN INCHES.

- A. Measure the length of each wall.
- **B.** Measure each window's width x height, location from corner, and height above the floor.
- **C.** Measure each door's width x height, location from corner, and direction of opening.
- **D.** Measure the height of the ceiling.
- **E.** Mark the locations and sizes of appliances.
- **F.** Show the size and location of island, if applicable.
- \*Include any other objects that will affect your kitchen design such as chimneys, posts, bulkheads, etc.


